**North County Youth Soccer Association  
Annual Report 2012**

In 2012 NCYSA had a successful year of soccer. NCYSA offered leagues at all levels of play for ages 3 through 18 with over 7,000 players and 750 teams.

NCYSA clubs offer a wide range of playing opportunities for our membership. At the recreational level, ten of our clubs continued to inter-tie our league with South and Central Whidbey Clubs, Snohomish, Terrace-Brier and older Skagit teams; as in the past this provides our organizations with a strong level of competition for players in the recreational program. Washington Rush (RCL) and North Sound, Granite Falls, Marysville, Silver Lake, Sky River and Sno King (NPSL) provided players opportunities to play at the higher levels of competition.

We had four (4) teams in the Recreational Cup Finals with 3 teams as State Champions – U12B Mukilteo Rhinos, U16B Mukilteo Altrec FC and U17G Sno-King SB Express. The North Sound U12B Legacy FC finished as finalists in the Challenge Cup.

NCYSA also sanctioned several successful tournaments in 2012. Specifically, the North Sound Diadora Legacy and Washington Rush Cup in July; the Marysville Strawberry Classic and Sky River in August, and the Mukilteo Turkey Shoot in November.

Referee recruitment and re-certification continues to be a major objective of NCYSA, numerous Grade 8 and 9 entry level clinics were offered throughout Spring and Summer in Everett, Edmonds, Lake Stevens, Marysville and Monroe. In conjunction with the North Chapter Referees several clubs hosted re-certification clinics in the spring and winter.
