



**North County Youth Soccer Association
Annual Report 2014 - 2015**

Player count for the 2014-15 season again seen a slight drop; numbers were around 7,330. NCYSA clubs offered opportunities for players ages 3 through 18.

Nine of our clubs continued to inter-tie our recreational league with teams from South Whidbey, Snohomish, Terrace-Brier and Skagit; this provides our organization with a strong level of competition for players in this program. This year we had one club fold which resulted in the Marysville Club to re-structure and now cover 3 school districts (Marysville, Lakewood North, & Arlington). The club is now Pilchuck Soccer Alliance (PSA). Washington Rush (RCL), Granite Falls, Irish, PSA, Silver Lake, Sky River and Sno King (NPSL) provided players opportunities to play at the higher levels of competition.

In 2011 we began a six week Rec. Spring League with 39 teams and 6 clubs and that continues to grow:

2012- 80 teams, 7 clubs

2013- 92 teams, 10 clubs

2014- 98 teams, 9 clubs

2015- 111 teams, 9 clubs

We had three (4) teams in the Recreational Cup Finals in December U12B Silver Lake Bombers, U15B Irish Legacy, U16B Silver Lake Russo (all finalists); the U17G PSA Strike Force (Champions). In 2015 President's Cup the U10B Washington Rush finished as finalists.

NCYSA sanctioned several successful summer tournaments in 2015; the Washington Rush Cup; the Marysville Strawberry Classic, and the Sky River Tournament. In November we had was the Mukilteo Turkey Shoot.

Referee recruitment and re-certification continues important with Entry level clinics being offered throughout spring, summer. In conjunction with the North Chapter Referees several clubs hosted re-certification clinics in the December 2014 and January 2015.
